**Agawam Hunt-Format-Both players hit their tee shots, choose one and now alternate shots until you hole out. So...you both hit tee shot, choose the one you want, if you use your partner's drive-you hit next then he hits til you hole out. And no, your partner may not replace your Solo for his ProV to putt-you must both use the selected ball in play all the way in. On the next hole, you start all over with both hitting tee shots, etc. This is not like the State Mixed where you have to determine ahead of time who's driving on the odd or even holes. Any questions-please ask.**

**Must use at least 2 drives from each player.**

Note in the sample scorecard ONE gross score was written per hole. The scores were then totaled for each nine and for 18 holes GROSS. Your team handicap will be written in the HCP box. Subtract that from the team gross score to get the team NET score. We would appreciate it if you did it as shown above. Note this team added wrong-but again, the player is not responsible for the math. Please take an extra moment to recheck the math. Also note, 2 drives per player were checked on the holes their drives were used. Thanks again for your efforts in helping get these cards neat and legible. When you complete your round, please turn in your cards before going to your car, the bathroom, etc.
