MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

Annual Membership

The application for membership is available on the website or you may contact any board member to have one mailed to you. Applications must be postmarked by April 1st of said year in order to be eligible for the Players' Championship and Player of the Year.

Your membership fee includes an invitation to our Annual Banquet, as our guest, held at the end of each season.

Five Dollars (\$5.00) from each membership goes to the Natalie A. Price Memorial Scholarship Fund, which offers financial assistance to post-secondary, female junior golfers.

Juniors

Junior Membership is free but an application must be filed annually. Juniors need not be active students to be eligible for Junior Membership as long as they meet the "under 21" age criteria. Juniors may compete in all tournaments for 1/2 the stated entry fee. Junior partners under 21 would also be extended the discounted rate. They will compete against the field. Parents are requested not to caddie. Spectators and family members are asked to stay off to the side and not interfere with play during matches.

Open Registration and Guest Policy

Please note that all events listed as Open events, as well as the Trudy Dufault Ryder Cup Championship, are open to all RI residents and any member of a club affiliated with the OSWGA. You do not have to be a member of the OSWGA to participate in these events; just pay the non-member fee listed. All events listed as Member events are open only to members, unless stated that you may bring a guest. The guest will pay the non-member fee listed for these tournaments.

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

Tournament Entry

Players register by filling out an entry form with the required information and then submitting it, along with the required entry fee, at any time between the opening and closing dates of the tournament. Do not send cash. Send check or money order only with mailed entries.

If the event is for a two or four person team, then ALL names and ALL required information, along with the COMBINED entry fee, must be submitted at the same time. Any entry postmarked prior to the opening date will be returned.

If a player's handicap index is not from GHIN, she should instead include on the entry form the following: the name and address of her golf club or organization and the name of the handicap server.

PLEASE NOTE!

If any course restricts the number of players or tee times allotted, the following criteria/preferences will govern entry into tournaments:

1. Date the OSWGA receives mailed, paid, completed entry card
2. Members of the OSWGA with the most seniority in the organization

No refunds or credits, with the following exceptions:

1. Cancellations received prior to the closing date of the tournament.
2. If any tournament has a waiting list and the cancelled entry can be replaced from the waiting list.
3. Cancellations made by the Tournament Course or OSWGA.

Player substitutions are allowed with 48 hours notice, and any subsequent exchange of entry fee must be handled by the players involved. OSWGA will not be responsible for any refund. Please be aware that substitute must have an active USGA Handicap or will play at scratch.

Cancelled and Rescheduled Events

Cancellation of a tournament will occur only when a course is deemed unplayable by an authorized official of OSWGA or the pertinent course. The Pro Shop will be notified if a tournament is cancelled. If, upon calling, no decision has been made, please report to the course. When time allows, emails will be sent to the registered players and notice posted on the OSWGA website. Information for any rescheduled event will also be posted on the web site. Those not able to play on the new date must contact the Tournament Director in the allotted time frame and their check will be destroyed. If no contact is made, the player/s will be listed in the revised pairings with attendance required, and their check will be deposited.

Senior & Junior/Senior Tournaments Age Requirements

Age requirements will be determined as of the closing date of tournament. Please refer to specific tournaments for age requirements.

Handicap Requirement and Determination

A USGA Handicap Index obtained from an authorized golf association licensed by the USGA to utilize the USGA Handicap System is mandatory for entering OSWGA competitions. Any participant without such a handicap will play at scratch. A player's Handicap Index will be determined as of the closing date of each tournament.

The OSWGA Handicap Committee has the responsibility of making certain that a player's USGA Handicap Index accurately reflects her potential playing ability. The OSWGA reserves the right to reduce a player's USGA Handicap Index in any and all OSWGA competitions after reviewing exceptional tournament play. This stipulation shall be considered proper notice for all

members (according to the USGA Handicap System, Section 9-2 and Rule 33-1 of the Rules of Golf). Further, the committee shall reduce or withdraw the handicap indexes of players who do not post all acceptable scores, or otherwise do not observe the spirit of the USGA Handicap System. A "reasonable amount of time" within which scores should be posted is considered one week.

80% Handicap at a max of 40, with no more than 1 stroke on a Par 3, will be used unless otherwise noted.

Team events with a 10 stroke differential will be played at 100%.

Handicap strokes for a 2 person team will be based on the lower player of the team.

Handicap strokes for a 4 person team will be based on the 2 lowest handicaps of the team.

Scramble handicap strokes for a 2 person team will be 1/3 of the lower handicap of the team.

Scramble handicap strokes for a 4 person team will be 1/4 of the lowest handicap of the team.

All 4 person teams must have a combined handicap of 25 or greater.

Tournament Play Championships

All competition will be played in strict accordance with USGA rules except when modified by the OSWGA.

Competitors must report to the registration table 30 minutes before tee time. No-shows, failure to turn in a scorecard or participants who fail to complete all scheduled rounds may be subject to exclusion from future tournaments by the committee. Carts are mandatory and included in YOUR entry fee in all events, unless otherwise stated. Choosing to walk does not discount your entry fee.

Caddies are allowed in all events, but your caddie must walk and carry your bag. Do not turn in your card if you have any rules questions. First refer to the Rules Committee. Then check your score card, attest and turn it in to the official scorer. Each player/team is responsible for the correctness of the score recorded for each hole. Any player/team who records a hole with a higher score than taken will have that score stand as recorded. Any player/team who records a lower score than that actually taken will be disqualified, UNLESS the score includes a penalty that was discovered only after they signed their card.

Participants are asked not to communicate with course management regarding questions or problems with a tournament. All communication should be directed to the TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE only!

Players will use the women's forward tees unless otherwise noted. Men will play from the men's forward tees unless otherwise noted.

Divisions, Flights and Pairings

The Tournament Director makes all Divisions, Flights and Pairings with the assistance of the Handicap Program. Additional factors include, but are not limited to: participation, budget and format.

Matching Cards

USGA guidelines will be applied as follows.

Individual medal play: For gross ties-cards will be matched by back nine, then back six, then back three and if need be, the eighteenth hole. For net ties, one half, one-third, one sixth of the handicaps will be deducted from the score for these holes. Fractions of one-half stroke or more will count as a full stroke.

Team events: For gross ties-cards will be matched the same as for medal play events. For net ties-cards will be matched starting with the #1 stroke hole, then the #2 stroke hole, etc. In the event that multiple formats are played within a tournament, cards will be matched on the best ball portion of the tournament.

Match play: the match will continue and the first player/team to win a hole will capture the match.

Prize and Point Distribution

Tournament Prizes and Player of the Year Points will be awarded based on the size of the field and format of the tournament.

Tournament Score Posting

When applicable, the OSWGA will post the scores of member participants. Non-members are responsible for posting their own scores.

Take Strokes Off Your Golf Game

One of the best ways to take strokes off your golf game is to learn the USGA Rules of Golf. Reading the definitions is another helpful hint.

Important Rules to know that will help shave strokes off your game:

Rule 20: Lifting, Dropping & Placing; Playing from a Wrong Place (With Rule 20 there is always another rule involved.)

Rule 13: Play the Ball as it Lies

Rule 18: Ball at Rest Moved

Rule 19: Ball in Motion Deflected or Stopped

Rule 23: Loose Impediments

Rule 24: Obstructions

Rule 26: Water Hazards Including Lateral Hazards

Rule 27: Ball Lost or Out of Bounds; Provisional Ball

Rule 28: Ball Unplayable

POLICIES AND CODES

Conduct and Behavior

We are guests at these courses and we owe them common courtesy and respect. Members are accountable for themselves, family members, and guests. Boisterous behavior and/or profane language is not acceptable from anyone once they arrive at the course and until they leave. It is the responsibility of all members to continue an amiable and respectful relationship with these courses so that we may continue to play there in the future.

Golf is played with etiquette as recommended by the USGA and the rich heritage of golf. Thus, each player is expected to play fairly, quickly, and with full consideration to the enjoyment of the game for themselves, their fellow competitors and others who are enjoying the golf course.

Please feel free to thank course employees/management for their hospitality. Support the Pro Shop, Restaurant and Bar where available.

Tipping the bag staff is strongly encouraged. Suggested minimum is \$1.00 – 2.00 per bag.

Cell Phone and Pager Policy

The use of cell phones and other communication devices is strictly prohibited during tournament play. This includes texting and while using the restroom once play has commenced. This policy also applies to your caddie. The **penalty** for violating this rule is **disqualification**.

Many courses do not allow cell phone use in or near their clubhouse. We therefore request that once you arrive at the course you place your phone in silent mode and/or turn it off completely. If you must talk either before or after the tournament, we request that you do so in the parking lot only.

Dress Code

The OSWGA depends on its members to dress appropriately and in good taste. Proper attire specifically excludes the wearing of short shorts, shorts and pants with bulky cargo pockets, cut-offs, jeans/denim, tennis shorts, tee shirts, body shirts, swimsuits and sweatpants. A good rule of thumb: if you have to ask, it is probably not appropriate!

Pace of Play

Speed of play is a critical issue in golf. For purposes of preventing slow play, the Tournament Committee will strictly enforce the pace of play guidelines. This includes stroke penalties for initial offenses, and disqualification for continued offenses. It is the responsibility of all competitors to maintain pace with the group ahead of them, not the group behind them.

Care of the Golf Course

Carts may not be driven on the tees, greens or aprons, and should be parked a minimum of 15 yards away. Keep them out of the fescue and other natural grass areas. Obey all posted cart signs, roped off areas and only two passengers per cart are permitted. Replace all divots, rake all sand traps, and fix all ball marks on greens.

Lift, Clean, Place

Lift, Clean and Place local rules will be in effect for the month of April and when noted on your rule sheets or score cards.

Suggestions to improve the Pace of Play

Play ready golf

Pick up if you are out of the hole

Advance to the next tee, then mark your card

When in doubt, take several clubs with you

Execute your shot without delay

Limit practice swings to two

Observe cart signs

Drive promptly after shots

Leave your cart in position to exit the green

Fire away when you are ready on the tee

Prepare and know when it is your turn to hit

Keep the group ahead of you in sight

Awareness and cooperation is key

LOCAL RULES FOR OSWGA TOURNAMENTS

USGA rules govern all play along with the following local rules.

Additional rules may be on the rules sheet for each event.

Distance Measuring Devices

Distance Measuring Devices (DMD) are allowed to measure or gauge distance only. DMD's that are designed to measure or gauge other conditions that might affect a player's play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.) are permitted, but those additional functions are not to be used during tournaments.

(Note: In accordance with OSWGA cell phone policy, smartphones with a DMD app may not be used as DMD's)

Stones in Bunkers

Stones in the bunkers are to be considered movable obstructions. USGA Rule 24-1 applies.

Embedded Ball

A ball embedded in its own pitch mark anywhere "through the green" (except the teeing areas and the putting green of the hole being played and any hazards on the course) may be lifted, cleaned and dropped as near as possible to where it lay no closer to the hole. USGA Rule 25 and Appendix I.

Individual Course Rules

PLEASE NOTE: Some local rules at courses may not be applicable to OSWGA tournaments. However, the OSWGA will respect local rules that protect the golf course (e.g. environmentally sensitive areas, newly sodded areas, flower beds and staked young trees).

NEW AND NOTABLE USGA RULES

3-3. Doubt as to Procedure in stroke play only.

If a competitor is doubtful of her rights or the correct procedure during the play of a hole, she may, without penalty, complete the hole with two balls. To proceed under this Rule, she must decide to play two balls after the doubtful situation has arisen and before taking further action (e.g., making a stroke at the original ball). The competitor should announce that she intends to play two balls; and which ball she wishes to count if the Rules permit the procedure used for that ball. Before returning her score card, the competitor must report the facts of the situation to the Committee. If she fails to do so, she is disqualified. The competitor incurs no penalty for playing the second ball.

6-6d. Wrong Score for Hole – Exception for Disqualification

If a competitor returns a score for any hole lower than actually taken due to failure to include one or more penalty strokes that, before returning her score card, she did not know she had incurred, she is not disqualified. In such circumstances, the competitor incurs the penalty prescribed by the applicable Rule and an additional penalty of two strokes for each hole at which the competitor has committed a breach of Rule 6-6d.

14.1B Anchoring

In making a stroke, the player must not anchor the club, either “directly” or by use of an “anchor point.”

18-2. Penalty for Ball at Rest Moved by Player, Partner, Caddie or Equipment

Rule 18-2b (Ball Moving After Address) has been withdrawn. This means that when a ball moves after a player has addressed it, the application of a penalty under Rule 18-2 will be based purely on whether the player caused the ball to move.

OSWGA POINT SYSTEM

Player of the Year

Members are awarded points depending on how they finish in a given tournament. The member who earns the most points in the time frame specified yearly will be declared OSWGA Player of the Year. Members who have earned enough points to get them into the top twelve (and ties) will be invited to play in the Players' Championship. This event is a celebration of the season. Players will compete for the top gross and net prize and join the victors in a celebratory meal!

Points may be awarded depending on the prize structure of each tournament as listed on the next page. Should there be flights in a particular division due to the size; each flight will be awarded points in the same manner. Should there be ties by two or more teams; points will be awarded equally to each team, as if each team was in sole possession of that position. This is in contrast to the calculation for prize purposes, which will still be decided by matching cards rules otherwise described in this handbook.

In order to be eligible for points in a given year, participants must be OSWGA members in good standing as of April 1st of said year.

All members are awarded 75 points for entering a tournament.

Point totals end with the tournament on September 19th.

Points after September 19th are NOT carried over to the next year.

(Board members have opted to exclude themselves from both the Players' Championship and Player of the Year.)
