Format-1 best ball. These tournament scores will be posted by OSWGA to GHIN. On the card above the team has circled the score they are using for each hole. Then they have brought down the score gross and deducting strokes when applicable, the net score. Note that on the 3rd hole, Chris picked up so has indicated an X-when adding her score she'll take her max which is an 8. *To clarify-Chris picked up after 7 shots prior to reaching the green-so she took her max. Had she been on the green lying 6 within a 1 putt, she would have taken her most likely score-a 7. You do not always take your max-sometimes you would take your most likely score-but never more than your max-for handicap purposes.* Note that on the 7<sup>th</sup> hole this team has circled the 7 and not the 6 as well as bringing down the 7. The scoring committee cannot change the score in a box, only a total. We must assume Jackie is taking her max as the 6 is not circled or just a human error-regardless the 7 stands. *(Please note the explanation of this hole was done when Jackie was a single digit handicap-at that time a double would have been max for this hole)* Add each player's individual score, add the gross, add the net and total for 18 holes. Note the math is wrong on the front 9 gross. The scoring committee has indicated the change on the card. Luckily-the player is not responsible for the math, the committee is-but the committee appreciates your attention to detail with the math. Card has been signed by both teams in the 4-some.
