

OSWGA BY-LAWS SUGGESTED REVISIONS AS OF MARCH 5, 2026 Revised
3/26/26

ARTICLE II Section 1. Strike the word “size” and replace title “Board Role, and Composition.” Size is covered in article III. (Board Approved)

ARTICLE ii Section 6. Change first line to: Resignations must be submitted to the Co-Founder or current President via postal mail, email, or in person. (Board Approved)

(lag comment) Because Article II section 6 covers the appointment of a temporary board member it appears that Kris Kennedy may assume the role right away for the remainder of the term left to serve. (Board Approved)

ARTICLE II Section 7. 3rd line: Strike the word four and replace it with “five” or 50% since we will have 9 board members. (Board Approved to use “five”)

ARTICLE III Section 1.a line 2: Replace the word eight and replace it with “nine.” (Board Approved)

ARTICLE III Section 1.a line 4: after Co-Founder add: “and IT Director” (Board Approved)

ARTICLE III Section 1.b line 3 add after Tournament Chair (s), and IT Director. (Approved)

ARTICLE III Section 1.b line 8: I suggest cutting “Those who cannot attend the meeting may request an absentee ballot from the Corresponding Secretary. Absentee ballots shall be postmarked four days prior to the election and shall not be opened or counted until the annual meeting. (Board Approved cutting previous sentences.) Changing next sentence to: Nominations will be accepted from the floor, allowing the candidate to give a brief verbal agreement with stated qualifications if they accept the nomination.” (Board to approve)

ARTICLE III Section 2d. line 4-5 cut: The Corresponding Secretary shall be responsible for promptly mailing absentee ballots upon receiving written requests. (Board Approved to cut)

ARTICLE III Section 2.i (adding new paragraph for IT Director) The IT Director shall be responsible for tournament entry into the Golf Genius software or similar applications in the present or future use of such software. The IT Director works closely with the Co-Founder/Tournament Director in defining event formats. The IT Director is responsible for the overseeing online payment for membership and events as scheduled through automated software. Additionally, communication with the Treasurer is required for follow-up on non-automated payments. This position also includes verifying accurate scoring for post tournament results along with the Data Coordinator and volunteers. Additional coordination is required with the Webmaster for the OSWGA Website. (Board Approved)

ARTICLE IV Section 5.b cut last line: Voting by absentee ballot shall be allowed for elections and by-laws. (lag comment: this line no longer needed with quorum acceptance) (Board Approved deleting this line.)

ARTICLE V Section 3.b change line 3 to » The Data Coordinator shall have management of score cards, team pairing, tournament scoring results, and designation of prizes along with the Tournament Director and coordination with the IT Director. (Board Approved)

ARTICLE V Section 3.c change line 4: Place a period (.) after the words “OSWGA website.” Add next line “The Webmaster works closely with the IT Director and various board members for additions and changes to the public OSWGA web presence. (Board Approved)

The following committees will be deleted from the titled Article V – Committees Section 3: Standing Committees The Title stays but the following are deleted.

Section 3.f Publicity/Membership Recruitment

Section 3.g Rules – The Rules Committee

Section 3-i Statistician – The Statistician Committee

As a result of these deletions the letter assignment under section 3 will change alphabetically as required.
